



Cleaner Production Case Study: Through Solar Water Heating International Trading Services Ltd.

This series showcases success stories of PaCT (Partnership for Cleaner Textile) partner factories in the Bangladesh textile sector that have implemented cleaner production projects.


Factory Status

International Trading Services Ltd. (ITSL) Wash Unit is a laundry facility and a sister concern of the Standard Group. The total production capacity of the plant is 70,000 pieces per day. The factory has 24 water flow meters to measure groundwater lifting, washing process, domestic consumption, utility use, and effluent treatment plant (ETP) inlet and outlet volumes.

Description of Implementation

ITSL has implemented a solar water heating system as suggested by PaCT program experts. This heated water is used in the dining section for cleaning and disinfecting utensils. ITSL has invested about \$512 in the solar system and as a result, approximately \$700 could be saved with a payback period of nine annually months.


